## Ninth Sunday After Trinity

**Jeremiah 23.23-29, Hebrews 11.29 - 12.2, Luke 12.49-56.**

*Dear Friends,*

*Jesus' words from this Sunday's gospel, "Do you think that I have come to bring peace to the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division! From now on five in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three; they will be divided: father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law" are incredibly hard hitting. With our tendency to think of Jesus as peaceful and loving, this passage can come as a shock. However, when we know and accept, through grace, that God is the fullness of our lives and our primary identity and meaning, we are able to fully love others, be the friend they need, and be the person God wants us to be.*
