Dear Friends,

God wants everyone to become the people he wants us to be, and that is, to be salt and light in the world. To show that the Kingdom of God is breaking in and does make a difference to people's lives. "When we lose this desire to "salt" the earth with the love and message of God, we become useless to Him". The salt Jesus spoke about was not the refined, clean salt we have today but rock salt consisting of salt crystals clinging to rock. Once all the salt had been picked off, just the rock remained which was discarded. This can make us question whether we are salty enough? Is this church being salt in the surrounding communities? Are wounds being healed? Is the Kingdom of God breaking through? Or is just the rock left over, making 'little ones who believe' stumble? As, after all "A moderated religion is as good for the demons as no religion at all - and more amusing."
